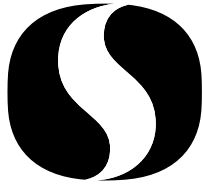

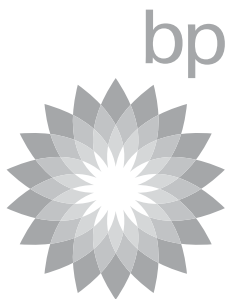


Anthem Blue Cross
